

Further expectations: Creating a conceptual framework for TFO (1), identifying interfaces between the SPS (1)/ finding out how to integrate the different SPs into the broader TFO concept (1) and to find out which data is needed/provided by the different SPs (1).

Individual Messages taken home: Many participants believe that the workshop constituted a good start, and that more effort has to be put into connecting the work of the different SPS (6) and especially the results of natural sciences and techniques of social sciences (1) with each other. The overall taken-home-message was positive and participants feel that that they learned more about the needs of the other groups. Some are convinced that TFO's interdisciplinary aim can and will be met if we initiate more planning and adaptation processes between the SPs (4). It was also mentioned that African partners need to be included more strongly (1).

Positive: Participants appreciated the constructive atmosphere (3) and the good, respectful discussions (4) during the workshop. Meeting and talking to different participants (7) and the competent moderation of the workshop (2) were mentioned as well.

Negative: The early beginning in the morning (3) but also the overall lack of time (3) were mentioned as negative. Some participants thought too much time was spent discussing "scenarios" and definitions (2) and issues relevant to just a few (1). Two participants perceived missing motivation for group work or for finding inter- rather than disciplinary solutions to key issues.

Way ahead: Overall, participants were satisfied with the workshop and its results. The meeting was furthermore identified as having been very useful for teambuilding and as relevant for further research planning. Accordingly, the need to integrate more people from the different SPs and to intensify interdisciplinary exchange was expressed. The idea was raised to use large workshops in combination with smaller more specific ones, where not all are invited. It was suggested that moderation and content could be separated in future workshops, when possible. Finally the need for discussing a final product for TFO in the next meeting was mentioned.

Also **urgent** was mentioned the **clarification of field work**, which is crucial for achieving the interdisciplinary goals as well: how, when, where exactly, with which VISAs, ect..
